NANCY R. POLAND resides in Coon Rapids, MN. She writes non-fiction books geared towards adults.

Book titles include:

CAROL MASCHKE resides in New Hope, MN. She writes Paranormal fiction series—an Irish ghost story with a romance geared towards 15+ but geared towards adults.

JUNE IRENE ANDERSON resides in Andover, MN. She has written and published ten books in a variety of genres. NANCY J. HEDIN resides in Arden Hills, MN. She writes books for mature young adults and adults. Her books have universal themes and are intended and enjoyed by a wide audience. Her books contain LGBTQ characters, but you don't have to be gay to enjoy them. There is humor, mystery, and romance in her trilogy.

- Her first novel Bend (2017) won a Goldie for Debut Novel of the Year and was named one of twenty-five novels to read for Pride by Barnes & Noble. Stray (2019) was a finalist for a Minnesota Book Award and Rise (2021) complete the Bend trilogy.

- The Spell was published by NineStar Press (2021).

JANET GRABER resides in Apple Valley, MN. She writes for adults, young adult and middle grade fiction, and picture books.

Book titles include:
